Luke 1: 1-4 (ESV)

"Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things that have been accomplished among us, ² just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word have delivered them to us, ³ it seemed good to me also, having followed all things closely for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, ⁴ that you may have certainty concerning the things you have been taught."

Introduction

1. Luke is writing about well documented history

2. Luke's writing is recorded eye-witness testimony

⇒ For example: Luke went to Jerusalem and met with Jesus' brother (Acts 21: 17)

- Evidence of eye-witness authenticity:
 - People's names
 - Place names

3. Luke's writing is well researched and orderly

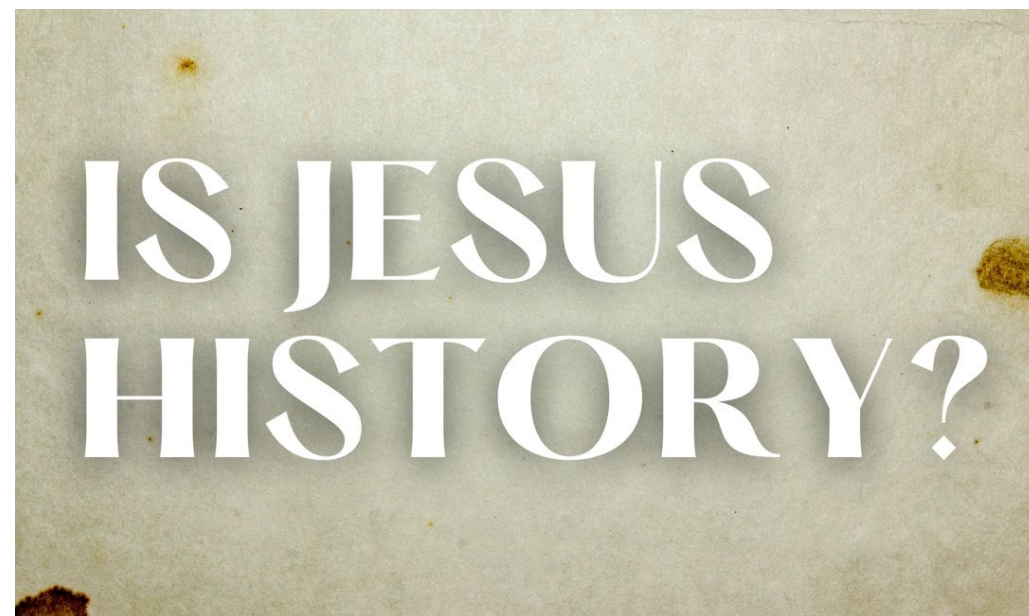
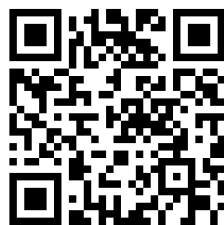
