- The reluctant prophet brought to his feet (1-3a)
- The great city of Nineveh brought to its knees (3b-5)
- The king who gets off his throne and sits in ashes (6)
- The people who gave up evil and violence (7-10a)
- The God whose word always achieves what he intends it to (10b)
