i. God promised to change people

*"I will put my laws on their hearts and write them on their minds"*  
(Hebrews 10:16, cf. Jeremiah 31:33)

ii. God promised to forgive people

*"I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more."*  
(Hebrews 10:17, cf. Jeremiah 31:34)
